Recovery of Osprey in Mid-Western Nigeria. An Osprey Pandion haliaetus ringed at Kangasala, Finland ($64^{\circ} 30' N.$, $24^{\circ} 11' E.$) on 1st July 1965 was recovered (shot) at Ashaka in Mid-Western Nigeria ($5^{\circ} 40' N.$, $6^{\circ} 25' E.$) about 4th December 1965. The recovery information was obtained from the Daily Times of Lagos for 7th December 1965 and the ringing data from the Museum Zoologicum Universitatis, Helsinki. The newspaper report stated that this bird is commonly known in Aboh Division as "Odinkpo".
